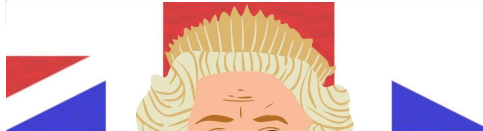
ROYAL

- Open your internet browser to library.edwardriver.nsw.gov.au
- Select the 'My Account' link
- **Login in** to your account using your card number as the user (ie:C123456) and your date of birth with no spaces and the full year as your password (1st Jan 2001 would be - 01012001)
- Select the 'Renew Your Loans' link from the right hand side 'quick links'
- Select 'Renew your items online now'

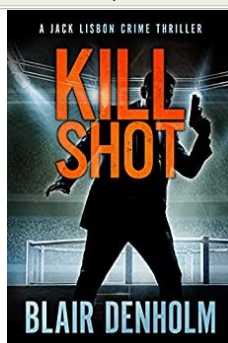

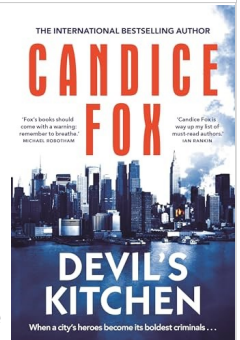
